Some children thought that moondust might feel like sand.








We put glitter and silver paper balls in a bottle of water. When we shook it and projected a light on it, it looked like the Galaxy.





Autumn Covid Vaccination Programme

Dear Parent / Guardian

The CYP Covid Vaccination team are carrying out a community clinic at **Cannock Fire Station WS11 6LD** on **Wednesday 15th March 2023 between 5:15p.m. and 7:45p.m.** to administer Covid vaccinations. This includes <u>ONLY</u> 1st & 2nd doses to those children between the ages of 5 and 17 who are eligible.

ALL BOOSTERS are NO LONGER AVAILABLE.

Your child is eligible for 1st or 2nd dose if:

- They are aged between 5 years and 17 years (had to be 5 years old on or before 31st August 2022)
- Have not received a Covid vaccination before
- If had a 1st dose needs to be 12 weeks before 2nd dose (8 weeks if Clinically vulnerable)
- Have not had Covid 19 infection within last 12 weeks (28 days if clinically vulnerable)

Consent will be obtained at the clinic by a registered professional. Consent needs to be given by a parent or guardian with parental responsibility or delegated authority.
